We are a three branch group of practices, our first practice opened in 2004 in East Grinstead, Edenbridge was the second practice to be built in 2013 with a brand new building for a cat only clinic built on site last year. We are proudly independent and committed to innovation and progression; we have invested in the latest equipment and technology: digital x-ray, dental xray, ultrasonography with doppler, Vet CT clinical assistance and PetsApp. Access to laparoscopy and endoscopy at East Grinstead.

Our team is the heart of our practice. We foster a supportive and positive work environment that prioritises the well-being of our staff. JOB ROLE

We are seeking an experienced vet to do a mixture of consulting, operating and non-clinical shifts and act as a lead vet/line manager.

CLINCIAL PART OF THE ROLE: The shifts can be tailored to individual schedules but are typically 8 hours and can support any areas of interest. Our consults are 15 minutes long and extended for more complex/time consuming cases. We book consults in a mindful way and make sure to provide time for admin, which is monitored and protected. There is no out of hours with this role as this operates out of our East Grinstead branch.

We have a weekend rota of approximately 1:6 Saturdays until 12pm, after which the East Grinstead branch takes over until 4pm then we are supported by Vets Now.

We provide comprehensive training programme for new graduates and student nurses. We would be particularly interested in a candidate who shares this passion for teaching and would be keen to be involved in mentoring and supporting our evolving team.

NON-CLINICAL PART OF THE ROLE:

- Liaise with practice managers, head nurses and the head vet based at East Grinstead (monthly meetings).
- Line manager for the Edenbridge vets:
 - Vet meetings
 - Conduct annual appraisals
- Mentoring and teaching students and new graduate vets (Vet GDP required or work towards).
- Evaluate new products and review XLVets star rated products regularly.
- Implement and monitor new protocols, ensuring consistency between the team (for example RCVS guidance updates).
- Assist Branch Manager in dealing with complaints.
- Awareness and input into the client experience including working with the social media team.
- Monitor billing to improve accuracy and standardisation.
- Monitor and (increase where able to) day to day efficiency.
- Conduct clinical audits with input from the vet team.
